# The Ten LOGOS Commandments

*Everyone is treated like a child of God and we treat others as children of God. We must also act (behave) as children of God.*

1. DO respect all people - big/little, light/dark, young and old. Treat everyone as a child of God.
2. DO walk, talk, gawk or squawk during Worship Skills, Bible Study and Family Time when instructed by the teacher. Otherwise, practice good manners.
3. DO follow the rules for Playtime according to the activity and the instruction of the leader.
4. DO remember a smile is a frown turned upside down.
5. DO remember to thank your parents and teachers now and then. They donate their time for LOGOS to help you grow as a child of God.
6. DO listen when others speak, for it is the polite thing to do. Use appropriate voices and never hurt anyone's feelings.
7. DO respect your "cool" things and not covet thy neighbor's. Please keep your "special" stuff at home.
8. DO treat your classmates as you would wish to be treated. Remember we are all children of God.
9. DO be pleasant and kind - NOT rude and crude. If you can't say something nice, don't say anything at all.
10. DO believe in yourself, for we believe in you.

## Consequences

1<sup>st</sup> Offense - Verbal Warning

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense - 10 minutes time out to reflect and/or discuss with a comforter what it means to be a child of God. The child will need to document in his/her own handwriting the offense and how it may have affected others. This will be mailed to the parents as notification.

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense - Extremely disruptive and/or repetitive disrespectful behavior will require an immediate phone call to parents.
